The National PNG OGP Conference held on 9th-10th September, 2021 brought over 50 Government agencies and Civil Society Organizations (CSO) together to jointly propose commitments for PNG's 2nd OGP NAP. At the Conference hosted by the Department of National Planning & Monitoring and the Transparency International PNG, a total of 21 Commitments were proposed for the 2nd NAP.

A 10-member Drafting Committee was selected with equal composition of government and CSOs, namely; DNPM, DOF, NEFC, DJAG, CIMC, TIPNG, Oxfam PNG, CELCOR, and Bread for the World. The Drafting Committee members that participated reviewed the NAP 2 proposed commitments and made a selection according to the OGP Standards and the feasibility of implementation in the 2-year period. Only 16 Commitments were selected for the 2nd OGP NAP.

The table above displays proposed Commitments during the National OGP Conference and the justification on why the commitments were not included in the NAP 2.
